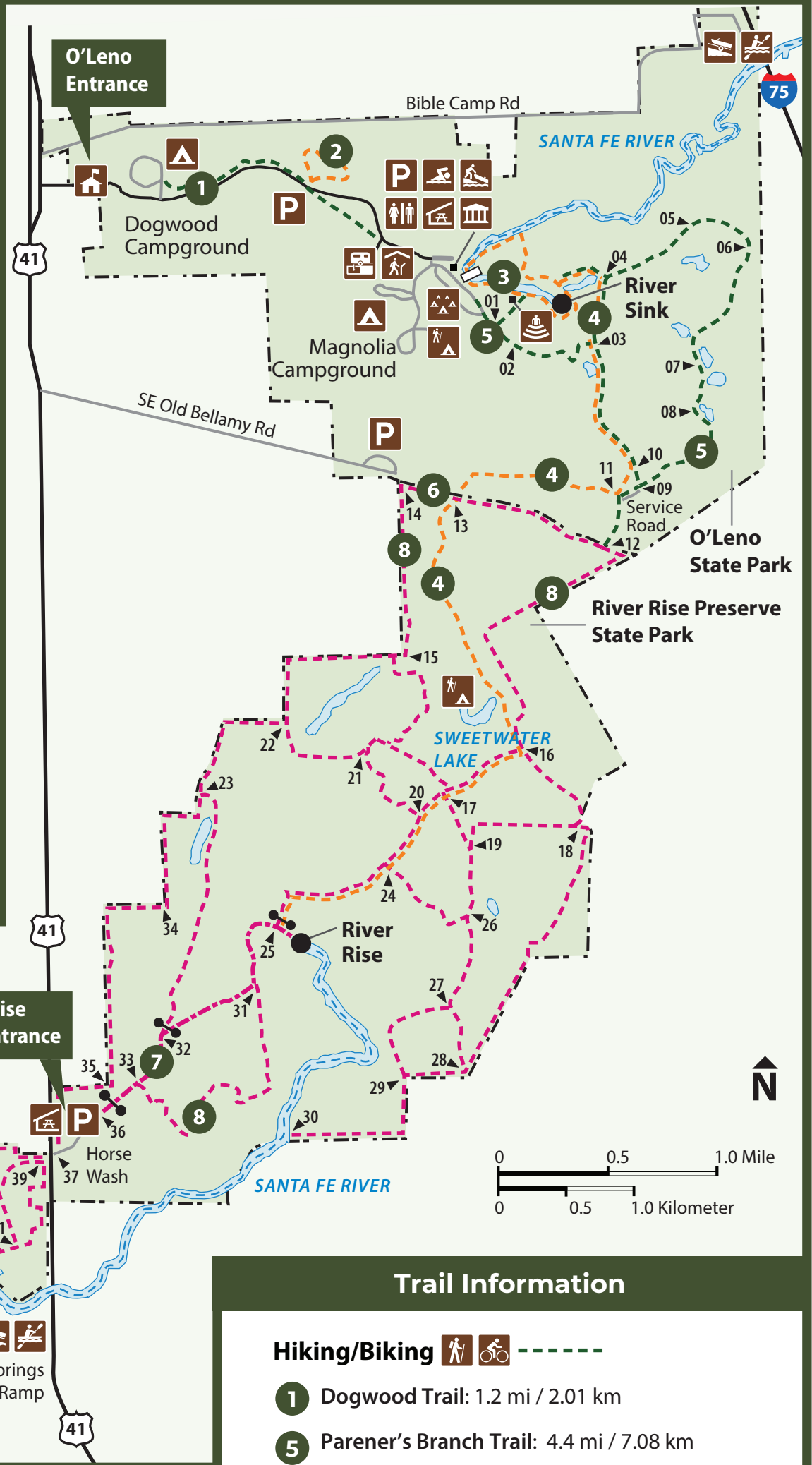

- 4** Sink to Rise Trail: 4.7 mi / 7.56 km

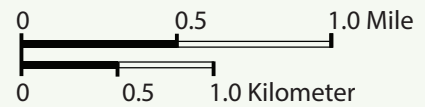

The Santa Fe River re-emerges from its three-mile underground journey at River Rise Preserve State Park, nourishing a landscape shaped by Florida's ancient geological past.

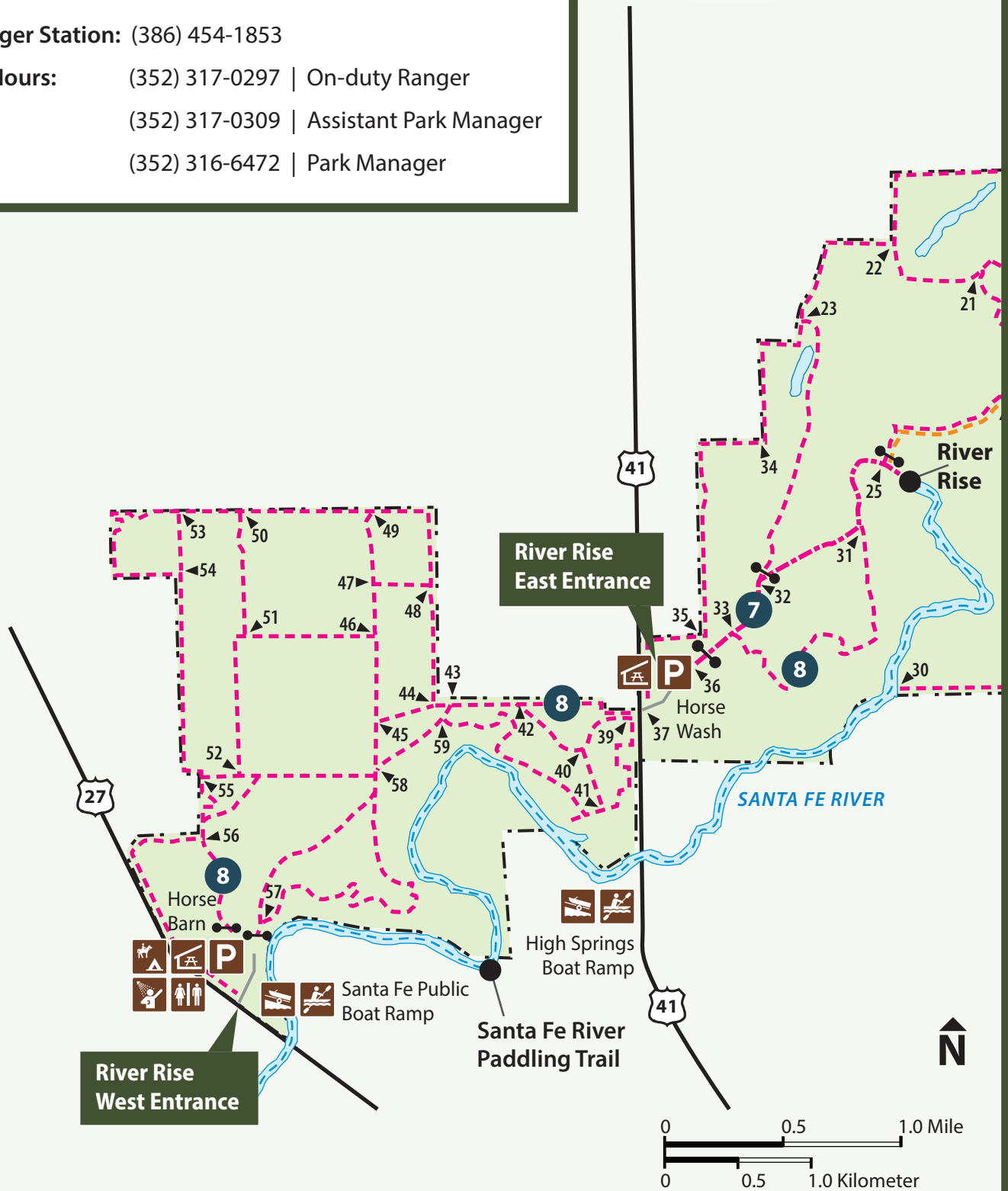
